Ligne Roset Furnishes Model Unit in Lenny Kravitz's Condo Project

Kravitz Design, the creative studio founded by rocker Lenny Kravitz, has unveiled its biggest full interior project to date: 75 Kenmare, a new Manhattan condominium done in partnership with architect Andre Kikoski.

Penthouse B, a three-bedroom duplex, has been newly unveiled. The unit, priced at \$7,695,000, features styling by renowned French furniture brand Ligne Roset, with luxe furnishings including the cult-fave Togo sofa by Michel Ducaroy and an Odessa dining table by Mauro Lipparini.
